- 2. What are some wise words of caution that a godly father should impart to his children in 2023?
- 3. Why is it important that Paul makes a distinction between the many instructors and a father?
- 4. Is it arrogant for Paul to point to himself as the right example to follow? Explain.
- 5. How does Paul show "tough love" in verses 18-21? Try to restate verse 20 in your own words.
