Small Group/Family Discussion Guide

Icebreaker: Share something you are looking forward to doing this summer; maybe a trip, summer project or other event.

Questions

1. Share something from Sunday’s teaching that was the most interesting or challenging to you, or that raised a question.

2. How does Romans 5:6-8 “prove” God’s love for us? What does God’s love mean to you personally – i.e. that YOU are the object of His love?

3. Notice the terms “ungodly” and “sinners” in verses 6 & 8. How would you explain to someone the importance of knowing that they (we) are ungodly sinners before God?

4. What logical point does Paul make in Romans 5:9-10? How are we saved by both Christ’s death (v.9) and His life (v.10)?

5. What does Paul encourage us to “rejoice in” (joy, exult, glory) in verse 11? How can we do this? (See also verses 2 and 3)

Small Group Prayer:

Be sure to begin each prayer by thanking God for His amazing love and the eternal security we enjoy in Christ. Also pray for those who have recently lost loved ones.
