
"Missions in Turbulent Times" (Acts 27-28)

Small Group Discussion Guide

Icebreaker: Share about a boat ride you've had. We'll take anything from a paddleboat ride to an ocean cruise!

- 1. What are some things we learn about God through the adventures of Acts 27-28? (e.g., His promises, protection, use of hard times, etc.)
- 2. What are some things we can learn from Paul as we consider how he handled the challenges recorded in Acts 27-28?
- 3. Consider the sad statement in 27:20 that "all hope was given up." How do times like these provide an opportunity for God to work, both then and now?
- 4. How exciting do you think it was for both Paul and his fellow believers when they finally saw each other in Rome? (28:14-15) How would you feel if you were there to greet Paul? What questions would you want to ask him? How could you be a blessing to him?
- 5. How does Paul use his "down time" of 2 years in house arrest? What are some possible "down times" in our lives in which we can use the time for God-honoring purposes?

Pray specifically for someone you know who is going through a storm of some kind in their life. Pray also for our persecuted brethren in northeast India, and for Pastor K. Vijay who will be with us next Sunday.
